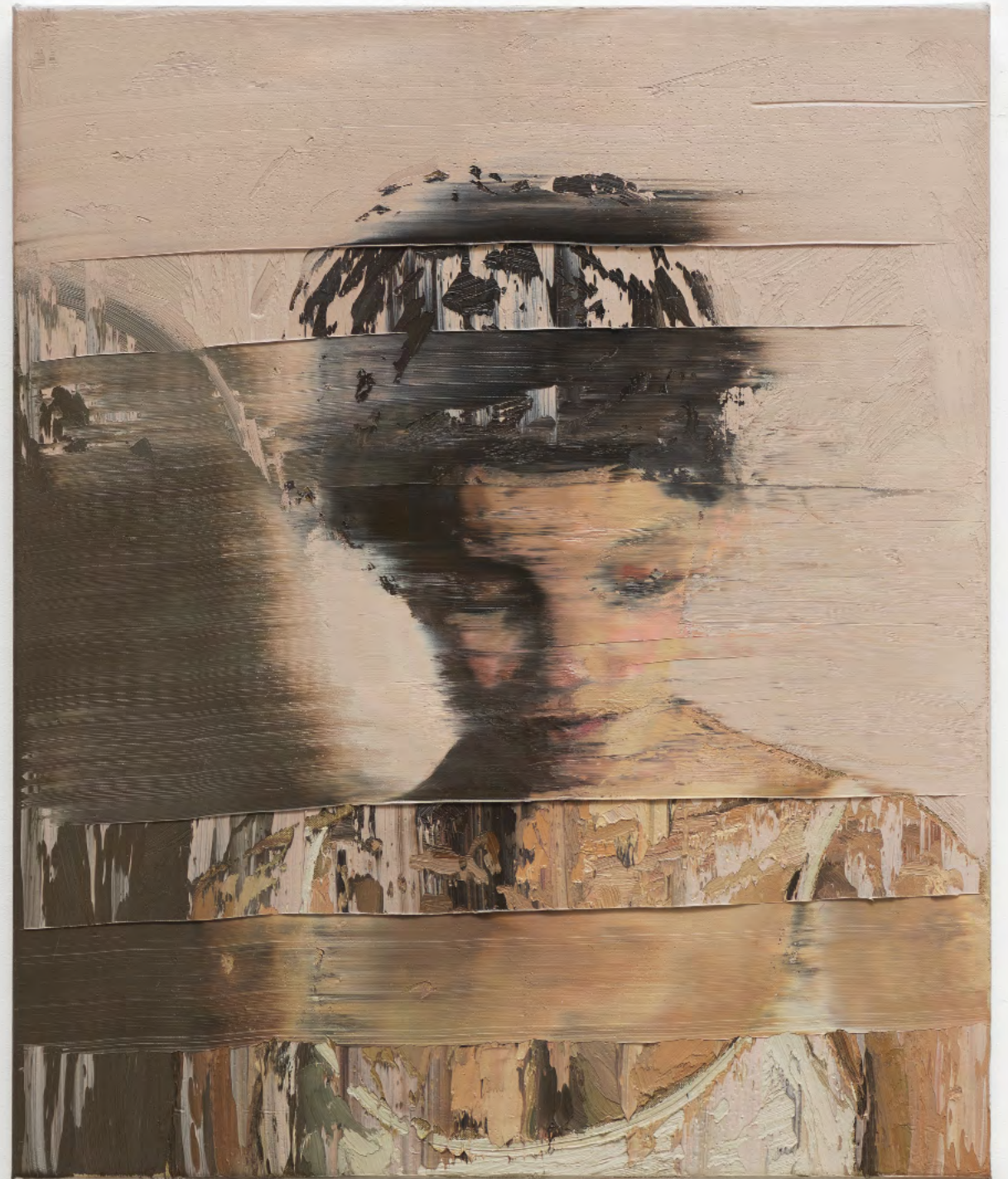


**Black Hands III, 2022**

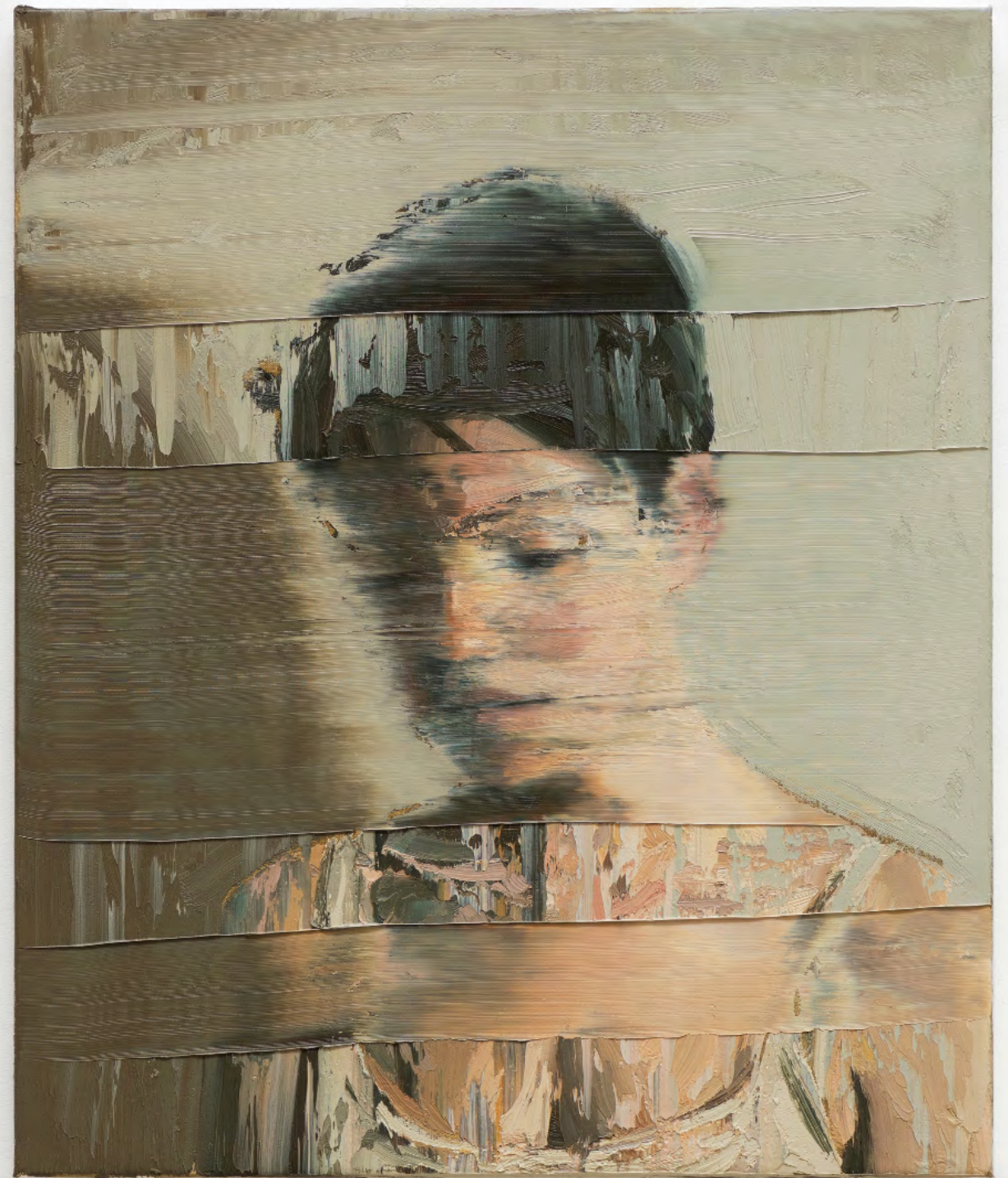


Study for Portrait of P. in Pink Cream, 2023

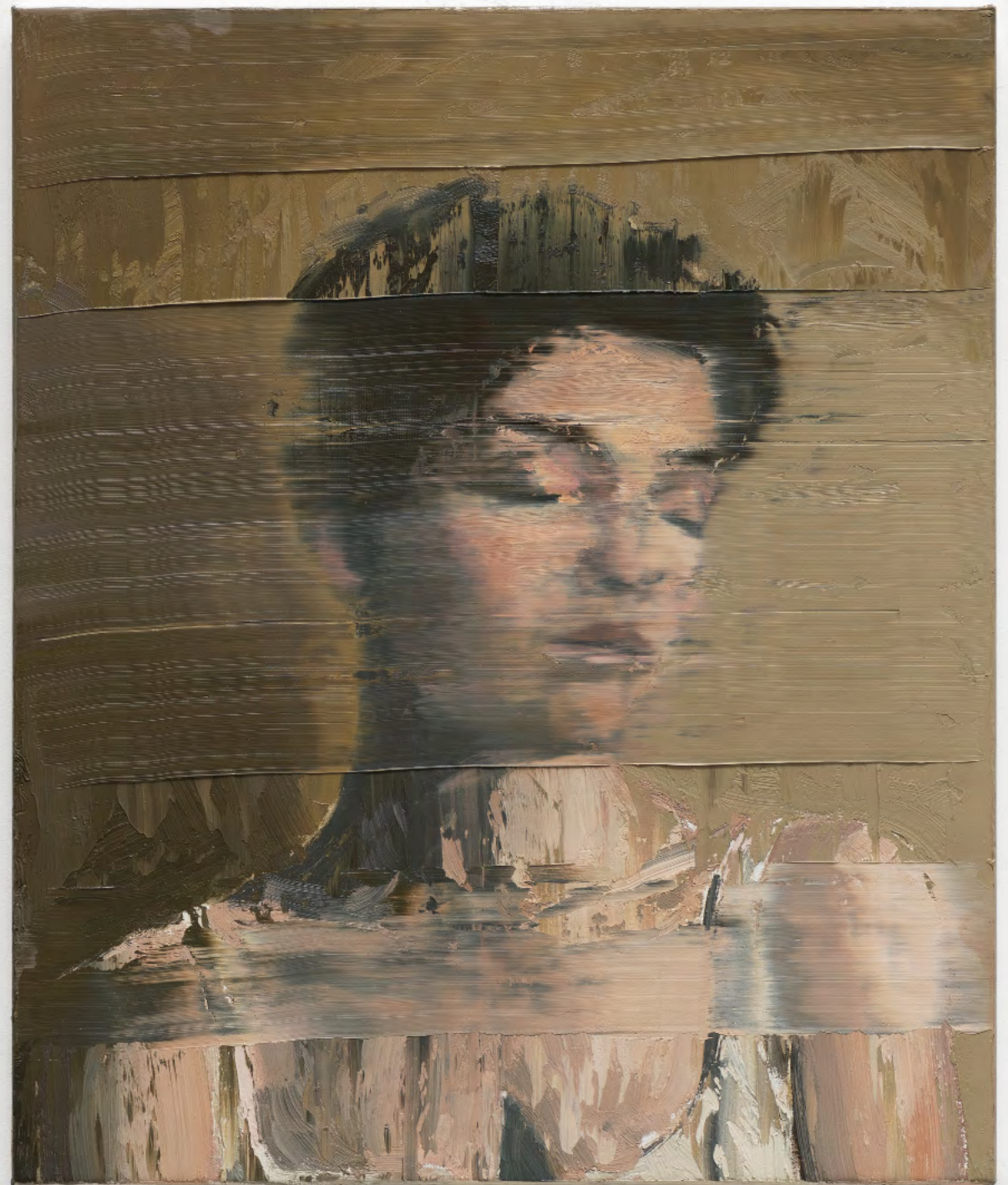


Study for Portrait of P. Cream Turquoise, 2023

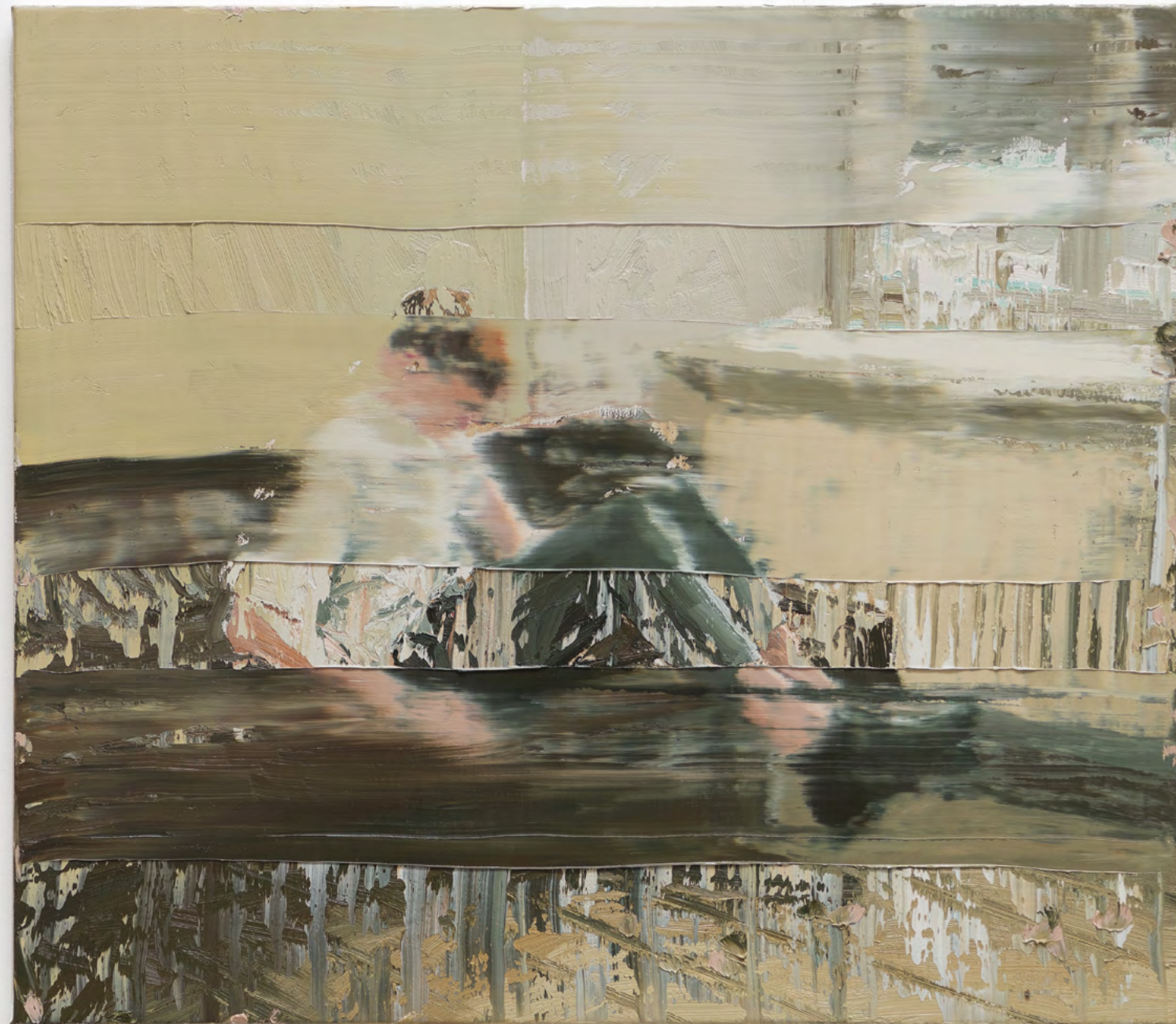


Study for Portrait of P. in Light Ocher, 2023

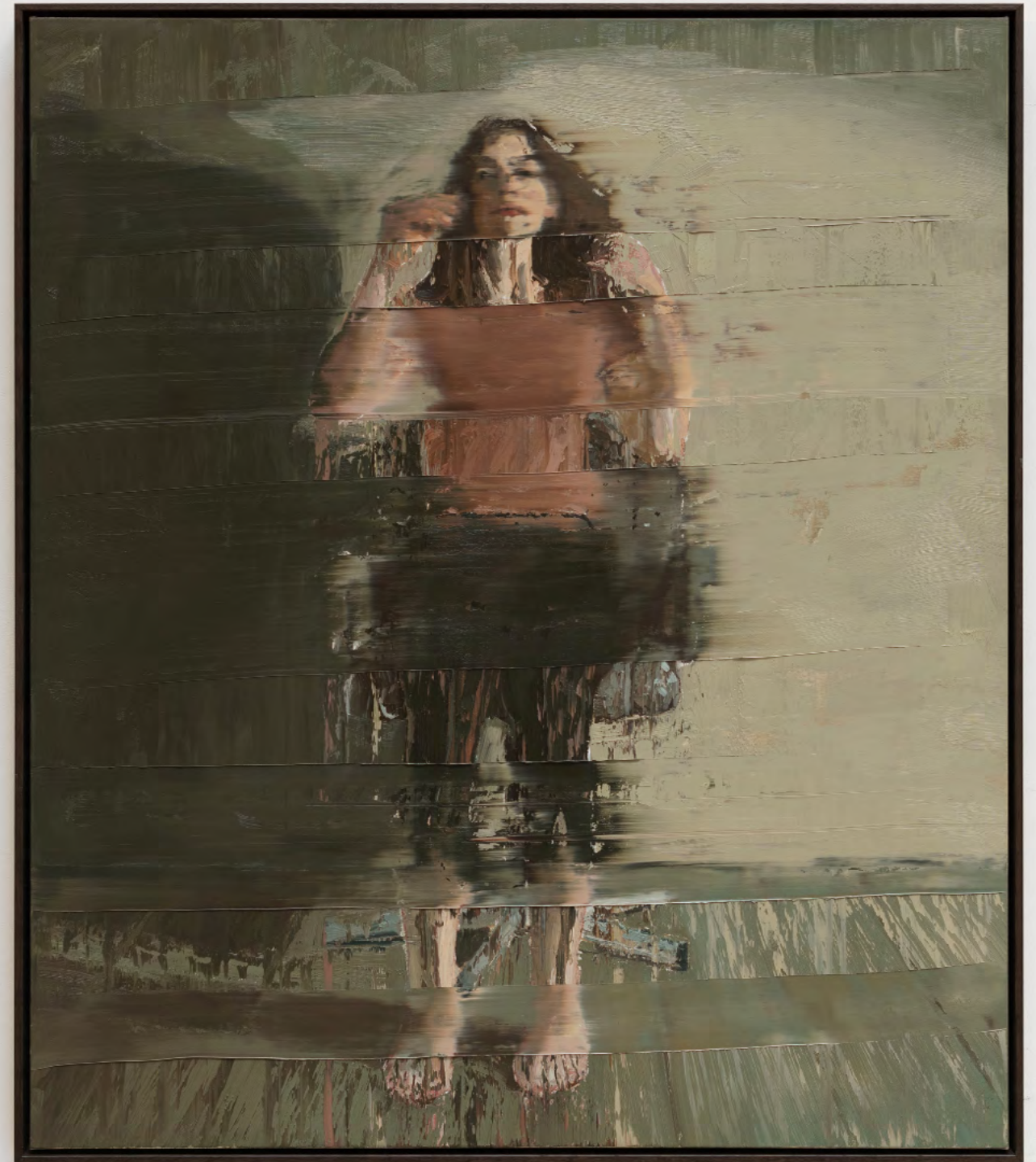

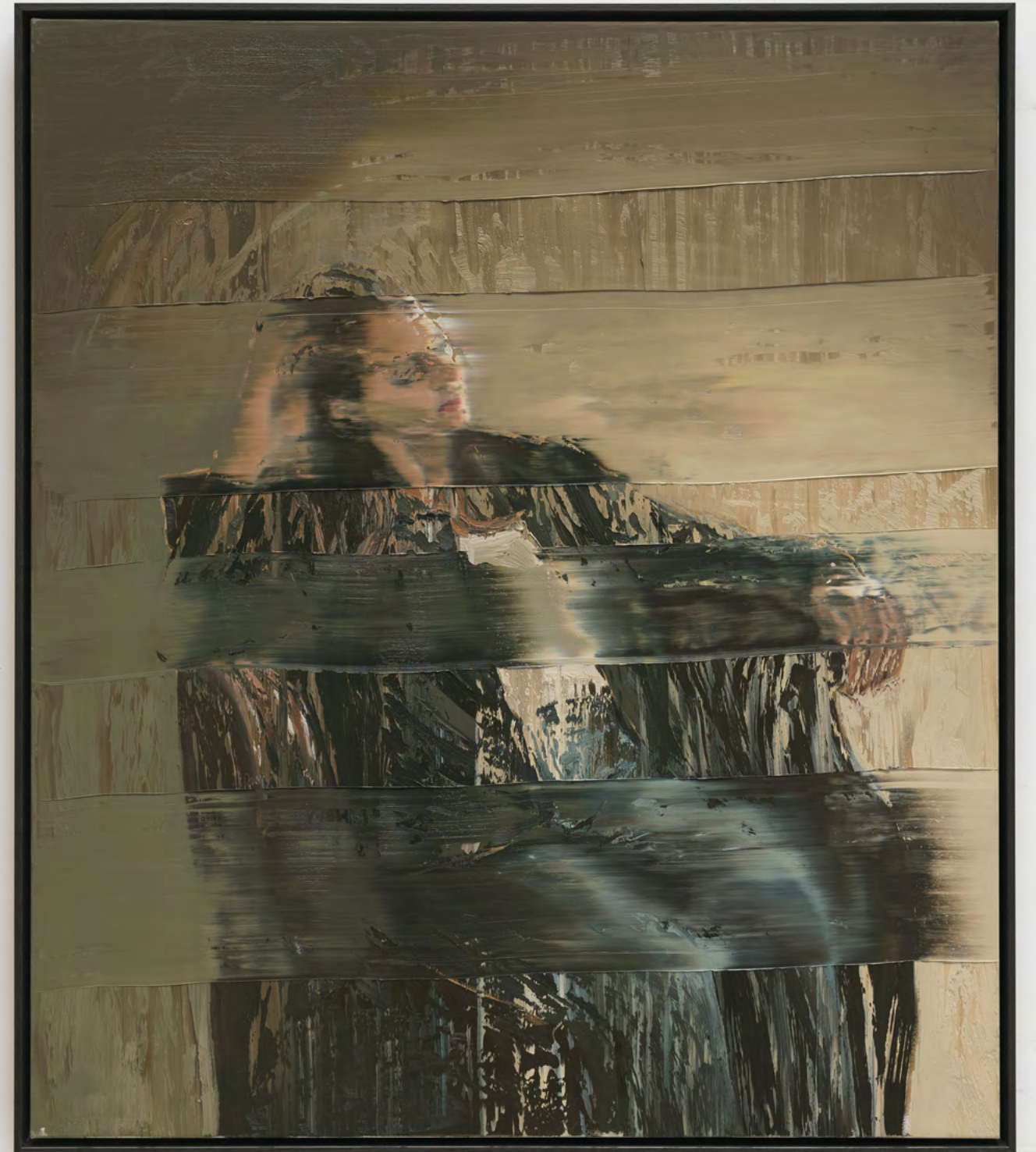

## Biography

Andy Denzler (born in 1965) lives and works in Zurich, Switzerland. In 2006, he received his Master of Fine Arts at the Chelsea College of Art and Design in London. His works have been exhibited in numerous solo and group shows in Europe, the United States and Asia in private and public institutions including the Gwangju Museum of Art, the Ludwig Museum in Koblenz, the Ludwig Museum Schloss in Oberhausen, the Kunsthalle in Rostock, in Germany and he recently had a major retrospective at the Kunstforum in Vienna. In 2015, Denzler participated in the 6th Beijing international Biennale and in 2016, at the 6th Marrakech Biennale. His art is featured in major collections including the Hirshhorn Museum, in Washington DC, the Denver Art Museum, the Museum of Contemporary Art in Montreal, the David Roberts Art Foundation in London, the Tel Aviv Museum of Modern Art, the MOMA Moscow, as well as the Museum Würth in Schwäbisch Hall, in Germany, the Burger Collection in Hong Kong and the White Cube Collection in London. A monography was published by Damiani.
