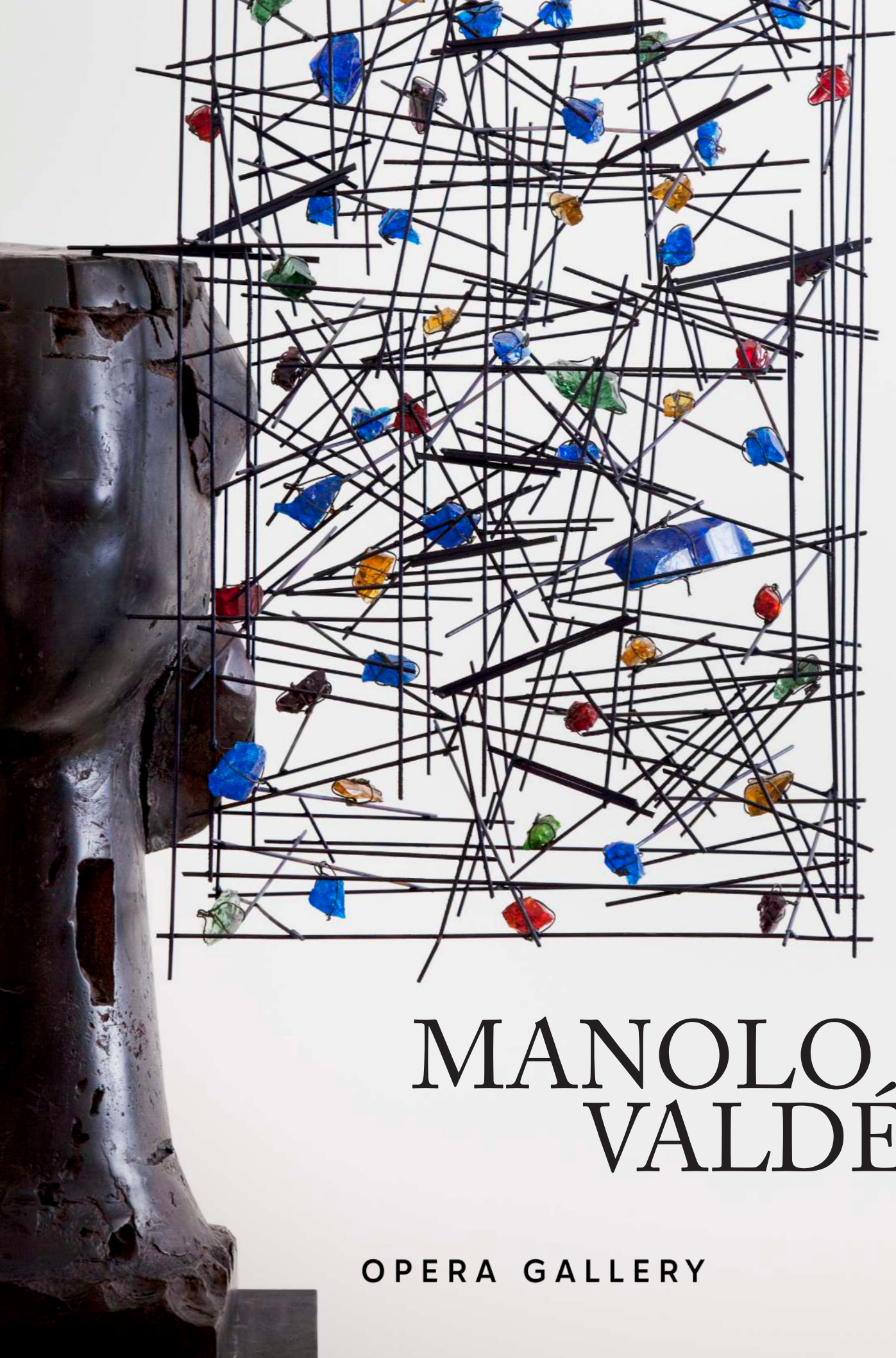

FOREWORD

Held in conjunction with Singapore Art Week 2026, the solo exhibition ‘Manolo Valdés’ brings together a curated selection of paintings and sculptures by the Spanish artist Manolo Valdés. This exhibition celebrates the singular vision of an artist whose work bridges centuries of artmaking and redefines the language of material and form.

Throughout his career, Manolo Valdés has engaged in a profound dialogue with the past—not just as homage, but as an ongoing conversation with art history itself. From the *Marianas*, *Margaritas*, and *Meninas* that reinterpret Velázquez’s iconic figures, to his abstractions inspired by Matisse’s silhouettes, Valdés transforms the familiar into something resolutely his own. His sculptural heads, often crowned with headdresses of abstracted forms, leaves, or butterflies, extend this dialogue—their compositions recalling both the grandeur of tradition and the fluid inventiveness of contemporary form.

As 2025 marked the 60th anniversary of the founding of *Equipo Crónica*, the influential Spanish collective Valdés co-founded, this exhibition also offers a moment to reflect on the group’s enduring impact on modern art, highlighting how Valdés’s commitment to experimentation and collaboration has reverberated across generations.

Presented during this season of artistic celebration—a reflection of the city’s vibrant, ever-evolving cultural landscape—Manolo Valdés finds resonance in Singapore’s own dialogue between heritage and modernity. Within this context, Valdés’s works speak across cultures and histories, embodying a universal language of form and transformation. They remind us that art is a bridge between worlds: between what has been, and what continues to unfold.

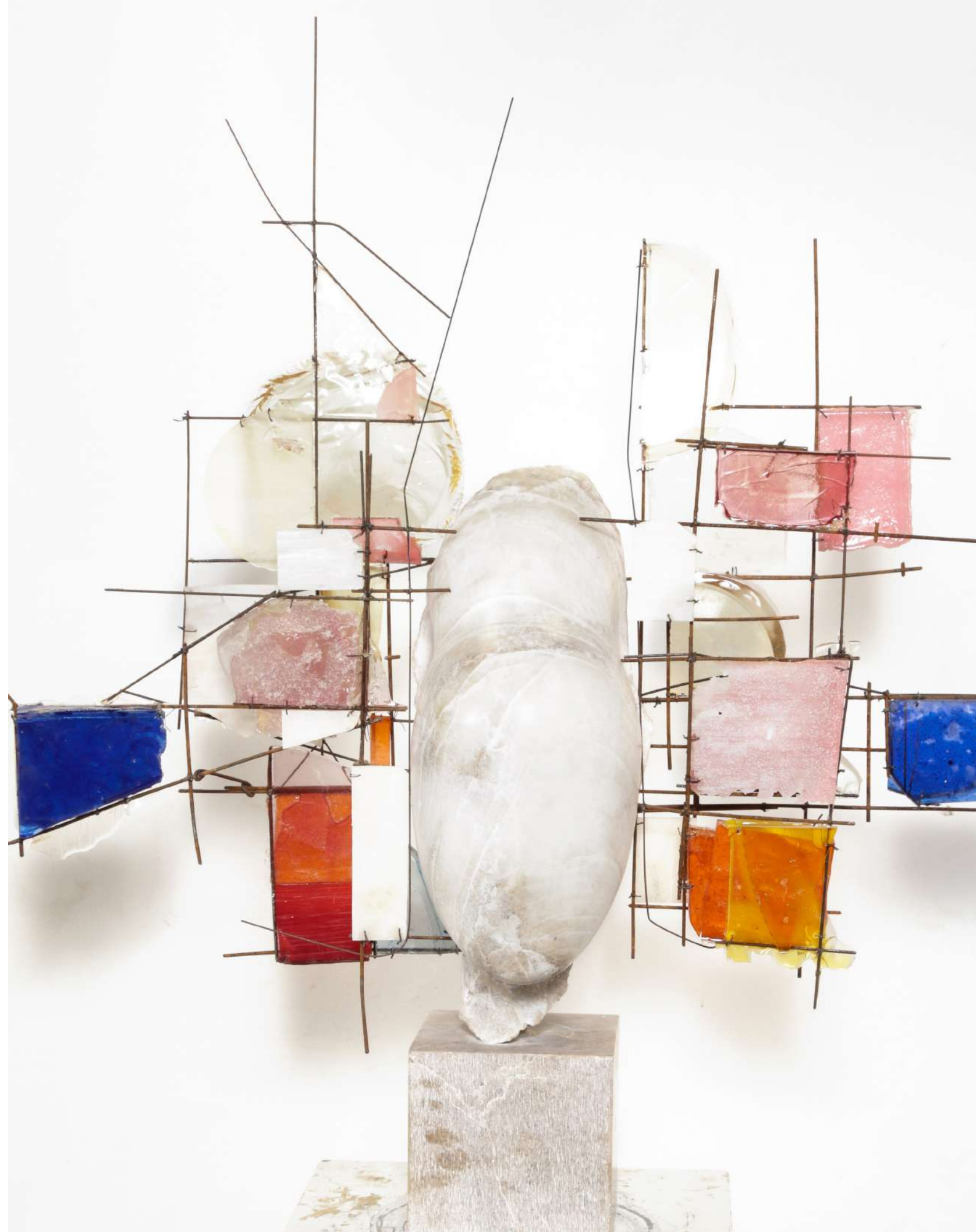

BIOGRAPHY

Manolo Valdés

(B. 1942)

Manolo Valdés was born in Valencia, Spain, in 1942.

Young Valdés embarked on his career as a painter in 1957 barely a year after entering the Escuela de Bellas Artes de San Carlos in Valencia, with the group Estampa Popular, where he used his paintings to criticise the Franco dictatorship. Along with his two friends Rafael Solbes and Juan Antonio Toledo, he formed Equipo Crónica, whose aesthetic was defined by its narrative focus during an era ruled by Art Informel and Expressionism. The collective later drew on American Pop Art, reinterpreting its codes.

Rafael Solbes' death in 1981 led to the dissolution of the collective, at which point Valdés began a solo career, revisiting masterpieces of the past.

He shed new light on Velázquez's mysterious *Las Meninas*, Picasso's Cubist portraiture, Matisse's Fauvism, amongst others. With just a few strokes, he captures the lines and contours of an iconic image, granting them unprecedented modernity. Velázquez's figure of Mariana de Austria, for example, already known from the Equipo Crónica period, became a leitmotif.

Valdés has lived in New York since 1990. In his paintings, he skilfully manipulates unconventional materials—for instance folded, stitched, or painted jute canvas, and tar—to create richly expressive textures. The hardness of the materials coincides with the strength of the symbol: an eyebrow or the bridge of a nose is enough to evoke a masterpiece of the past, consecrated, thanks to Valdés, with renewed modernity.

In sculpture, he works with materials including wood, bronze, brass, alabaster and marble. His sculptural creations have been seen in various public spaces around the world. Today, a part of his work appears in the collections of the most important international museums: the MoMA and the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York, the Centre Pompidou in Paris, the Kunstmuseum in Berlin and the Museo Reina Sofía in Madrid, among others.

Manolo Valdés currently lives and works between New York and Madrid.
